This past year was, by many measures, the most successful in the College's history in terms of fundraising. Driven by several large bequests, payments on pledges from the Journey Campaign, a number of major new foundation commitments, and another year of strong growth in the Annual Fund, the College set many new highs. Gifts were given to support a wide range of purposes, from classroom renovations to scholarships and were made both for current operations and endowment. While I anticipate a lower total this coming year as gifts from the previous campaign drop off, I believe that this strong showing bodes well for our future success.
