**January 15:** United Nations Offices, Freud Museum, Hundertwasser House

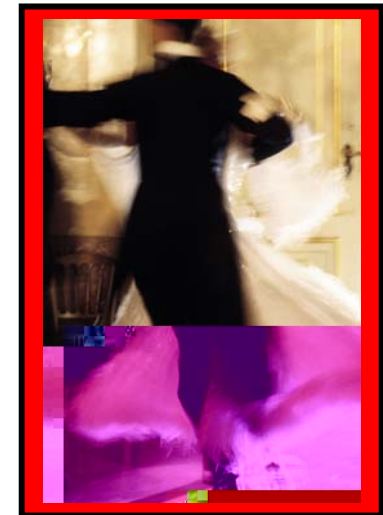
**January 16:** Free day in the city to explore
